- New Volunteer On Site Training. A full day of orientation at Ignite World Headquarters. Bring lunch and dress for being outside.
- If you are taking Alpine Visually Impaired On Snow Clinic
 - “Introduction to Visually Impaired” Online Training Video
 - The Visually Impaired documents on the Ignite web site. On your Ignite Account page click on “Training Documents and Forms”

On Snow Training Required:

- Alpine Teaching Progressions– found in the Alpine Section of Clinics.

And one of the following

- Alpine Adaptive Teaching 100 – found in the Alpine Section of Clinics.
- Alpine Visually Impaired – found in the Alpine Section of Clinics.
